GCP2 – how do I gather the information?

 Once you have decided on a family that would benefit from GCP2, talk to them about the tool using a strength-based approach 2. Speak to other professionals in the network – they can do part of the assessment if GCP2 trained or can share relevant information if not



6. If there are any
disagreements with parents,
note these down. These can
be a good discussion point.
However you should always
score based on what you have
observed



5. Make sure any information is reliable – check if unsure.
You can miss out any sections if you can't find out everything during the assessment window

3. Decide on an assessment window (ideally 4-8 weeks). Only use information gathered within this timeframe

4. Use your observations of the family, their home and their interactions to gather evidence. Also include information provided by family and professionals
