- The Independent Chair's Accountability Report 2022-23 has been published.
- The <u>Business Improvement Plan 2023-25</u> is available to download from the BSCP website. The Safeguarding Partners have identified four priorities for the next two years, which the Executive Board will oversee the effective implementation through the Business Improvement Plan.

Priority 1: Ensuring effective implementation of 'Working together to Build Strong Family Foundations'. (<u>Childhood Neglect Strategy 2022-2026</u>)

Priority 2: Assuring a coordinated and coherent inter-agency response to children impacted by domestic abuse and violence in families

Priority 3: Developing a joint approach to understanding and responding to children who are, and who become, invisible to services

Priority 4: Enhancing anti-discriminatory practice, by improving partnership focus on the work we do, in the context of equity, equality, diversity and inclusion.

Private Fostering – Getting it right for privately fostered children in Birmingham



Kim Smith, Assistant Head of Fostering SGO & CP, Birmingham Children's Trust delivered an informative <u>presentation</u> on Private Fostering and what action you should take if you identify/suspect a private fostering arrangement.

If someone who isn't a close relative cares for a child for more than 28 days, this could be a Private Fostering arrangement and Birmingham Children's Trust must be notified.
