#### The National Referral Mechanism - What? Why? When? How?

Karen Laing from NWG delivered an insightful <u>presentation</u> on the NRM process. The NRM is used for identifying & referring potential victims of Modern Slavery. Karen explained why the NRM was created, under what circumstances it should be used, and the process for making referrals.

# Serious Case Review BSCB2018-19-01: The importance of early planning and continuity of care for children with complex needs (published 21st February 2024)

- This <u>report</u> highlighted how agencies worked together around early planning and continuity of care for a child with significant and complex needs. It was noted there have been substantial positive changes since this Serious Case Review was undertaken in 2019.
- To support dissemination of learning a <u>one page briefing note</u> for practitioners has been produced alongside a <u>PowerPoint presentation</u>. Furthermore, in March 2024, the Partnership delivered a <u>webinar</u>, which explored in more detail the emerging learning from this Serious Case Review for improving safeguarding practice.
