# The Incentive and Eligibility

- A payment of £250 per successful family outcome
- Capped currently at 1,500 families across the city
- Family must have been worked with in the last 2 years
- Families must present 3 out of the 10 needs in the Outcomes Framework
- All needs, including emerging needs must have been resolved
- Need to be supported by a whole family assessment and plan

- Submit your Early Help Assessments and Plans through ECINS
- Complete a Closure form on ECINS to confirm all needs are met

## Think Family Programme:

- Payments to be made the month after the quarter end (e.g. January 2024, April 2024, July 2024, October 2024, January 2025 and April 2025). • Payments will be issued by the Education Safeguarding Team
- Quarterly feedback on family outcomes achieved by school
- Support in identifying outcomes and understanding the Outcomes Framework
